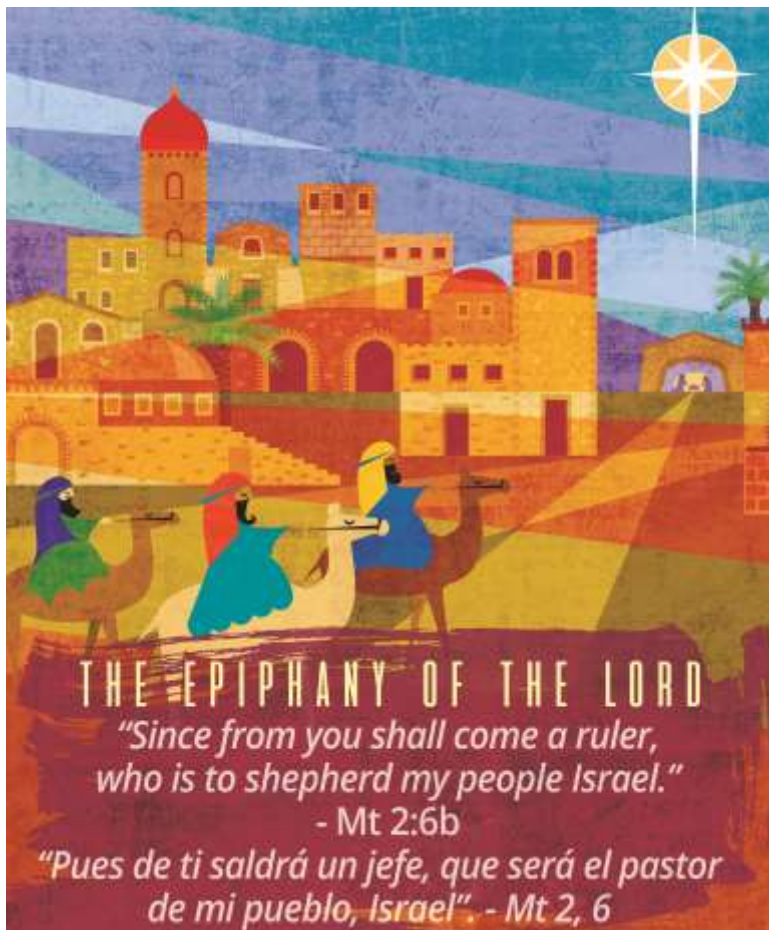

Good People of Holy Cross,

"Where is the infant king of the Jews?," the wise men ask. Where is God? Where is Jesus in our lives and how do we find him? The presence of God is like a star, sudden and beautiful and beyond our control. The wise men can't make it appear, they can't produce it. It's a star, it's a created thing, a wonderful thing, and they can only follow it. How do we know the will of God in any particular situation? By thinking of how we can serve, not be served, by thinking of who is weak, not who is powerful, by surrendering our need for control and obeying the beauty and spontaneity of the moment.

Let's apply the wisdom of the wise men to the issue of immigration. Millions of people in the world can no longer make an honest and dignified living in their own countries, for reasons of violence and injustice, so they seek a better life here. Our Church has made it clear that we are one people, that our unity is to be celebrated, that our diversity is to be celebrated, and that while each nation has the right to protect itself, we all have an obligation to make room for the dispossessed. And why is this? The star appears over a stable, not a mansion. It leads to a person, not a pot of gold. We can always be sure that we are doing the will of God when we side with the vulnerable, with the weak, with the helpless.



As we journey together in this brand New Year, let's us continue to find God in everyone and everywhere!

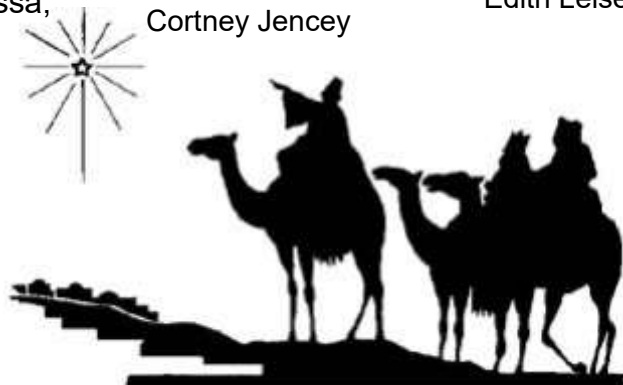
