Family Delayed Sacrament Program - Sunday 11:45- 1:00pm

Grades 3rd thru 12th

(Families whose children need Baptism, Confession, or First Communion)

Family Special Sacraments are for families who have a child in 3rd grade and above that need any of the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation or Eucharist. Families come together twice a month to learn about their faith. At least one parent must participate in the family sessions. Families are expected to attend Mass before or after the Family Sessions and on weeks that no session is held.

The Delayed Sacrament program is a two year program where children will be Baptized in the Winter of the first year and receive Reconciliation in the winter of the second year and First Communion in the Spring of the second year. Families are encouraged to continue to send their children to Faith Formation after they have received their sacraments.
